Turn left onto Main Street and go about 6 blocks (past Chutters Candy Store on left, Pollyanne statue on right, Thayer's Inn on left). Across the street from Thayer's is the Littleton Community Center (your destination) Turn right into the parking lot and park for free at the back of the building. Enter up the back ramp and through the door (bathroom on the left, registration straight ahead) This historic building was built in 1884 as a private residence and purchased later by the town as a community center and memorial to the soldiers and sailors of World War I.
